July marks the grand opening of the new Warren Center and Musgrave Event Lawn here at Lake Junaluska. The anticipation surrounding grand openings embodies a culmination of countless efforts and dreams. Witnessing the completion of construction is a moment steeped excitement in and accomplishment, where what were once mere blueprints and designs now stand as tangible structures, breathing life into aspirations of ongoing ministry and transforming lives. For those involved from architects to builders, visionaries and charitable supporters - it signifies the realization of their collective creativity and perseverance. Each detail meticulously crafted and each hurdle overcome, the grand opening is not just an event but a celebration of innovation and dedication. It symbolizes a new beginning, inviting others to share the joy of dreams made real and possibilities brought to fruition.

The Warren Center includes 3,372 square feet of meeting/function space and can accommodate groups ranging from 50 to 200 participants. The Musgrave Event Lawn, located between the Chrissy Hill Scenic Overlook/The Terrace Hotel and Warren Center, is 2,900 square feet of breathtaking outdoor space with awe-inspiring views and enough room for outdoor receptions or weddings of up to 200 or more.

We look forward to seeing you at the Warren Center on July 3rd for the annual Junaluskans social gathering and on July 7th, the Warren Center will host the Lake Junaluska Assembly Property Owners Organization (LJAPOO). Throughout the rest of the month, the space will welcome groups ranging from The Southeastern Jurisdiction of the United Methodist Church to two wedding receptions.
